You recently received [notice](#) that as of March 18<sup>th</sup>, National University campuses and facilities would be inaccessible to students, faculty, staff, and the general public until further notice. This decision is as a result of guidance and direction from federal, state, and local public health agencies.

As a result of this, the University has made the difficult decision of suspending federal work-study until further notice. If you are currently scheduled to work after March 18<sup>th</sup>, please respond to this email. Financial Aid representatives will communicate with your supervisors.

Financial Aid representatives will coordinate with your assigned supervisors once campuses are accessible to discuss individual students' remaining funding. Your supervisor will connect with you to discuss revised work schedules moving forward.
